

Smoking Needles Machine Knitting

Easy Cut & Sew Neckband

For Standard Gauge Machines

1. After marking, stitching, and cutting desired neckline, join one shoulder seam.
2. Hold the cut edge up to the machine to determine the number of stitches needed.
3. Cast on with scrap and ravel cord.
4. With main yarn knit 6 rows. End with carriage on the right.
5. Take off on garter bar.
6. With the right side of the garment facing you, hang garment neckline onto the same needles **behind** latches.
7. Hang stitches from garter bar back onto the needles inside of latches.
8. Close all latches and push neckband stitches through garment neck edge.
9. Knit 6 more rows--**take extra care when knitting the first row.**
10. Hang main color stitches from ravel cord onto needles.
11. Bind off around gate pegs.
12. Remove ravel cord and scrap.
13. Join second shoulder seam.
