

Smoking Needles Machine Knitting

Male Fashion Doll Sweater

While this pattern is very labor intensive it is fun as well. I was never comfortable with using my ribber until I started making these! Not only will you get lot of use out of your ribber with this sweater you will also get practice with shortrowing, decreasing with 2 prong tool and binding off. Decorating the sweaters with embroidery before sewing side and underarm seams is optional!

Materials: Really small amounts of Tamm Diamante

Machine: Any standard gauge machine with ribber

Tension: 4.1

Gauge: 8 st/ 12.5 r = 1" -- Exact gauge is not necessary

Front and Back: Knit 2 alike

CO in 1x1 rib over 36 needles. At SS 2 knit 10 rows (cast on rows are included). Transfer all sts to MB. RC000. At MT knit to RC36. Hang markers on end stitches. Knit to RC 48. Set machine to Hold. Put all needles to the left of R7 into Hold Position. * KWK, - 1x2, KWK, -1x1, KWK. 8 sts remain. Break main yarn. Remove 8 sts onto scrap yarn.* Move carriage to left side of machine. Place needles left of L7 into working position. Follow * to * above.. Set carriage to knit normal. Knit 1 row. COR. Transfer remaining stitches to 1x1 rib set up. At tension 2/2 knit 8 rows of ribbing. BO loosely.

Join shoulder seams: With right side facing you, hang 8 shoulder sts on needles behind latches. With the wrong side facing you, hang 8 shoulder sts on needles inside of latches. Pull sts though and BO loosely. Repeat for other side.

Sleeve

With wrong side facing you and over center 24 needles, hang sweater between markers. Shoulder seam should be at zero. Knit 6 rows. Using 2-prong tool, - 4x1 EV 8 rows to RC 36. Transfer remaining stitches to 1x1 rib set up. At tension 2/2 knit 4 rows of ribbing. BO loosely.

Block sweater. Seam side seams, work in yarn ends. Seam neck seam.
