

Smoking Needles Machine Knitting

Passap Dishcloth

I don't like washing dishes anymore than the next person, but I am very passionate about my dishcloths. I make all of my own. Some by hand; some on my bulky machine. My requirement is that they measure about 11" by 11" and for the most part hold their shape once they get wet. That is the real test! The cloth below comes off of the machine ready to use although I do prefer crochet trim.

DM80

With 4 strands of 20/2 or 16/2 cotton, SS 3/3 and using combs and weights, FNR CO over 75 needles--L40-R35--both beds.

On FB remove pusher from rail for every needle in WP.

Insert card #16 into card reader

Attach selector to lock and set to 4.

SS 4/4. Locks N/BX

Knit 199 rows.

Detach Deco selector from lock.

Change locks to N/N. Knit 1 row.

Transfer all sts to BB.

BO around needles.

With size 5 steel crochet hook work 5 double crochet 1 slip stitch the entire length of both side edges.

E6000

Use same needles as DM80 w/CO 2 and Stitch Pattern 1128 KT 251.
