

Smoking Needles Machine Knitting

Passap Seat Cushion

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This cushion takes less than an hour to knit and measures approx. 17" x 17". It uses small amounts of double stranded 2/24, Tamm 3- ply or any other comparable yarn. You will also need a small bag of polyester fiberfill. The Passap combs and weights are optional.

Put 102 needles in WP on each bed. L51-R51.

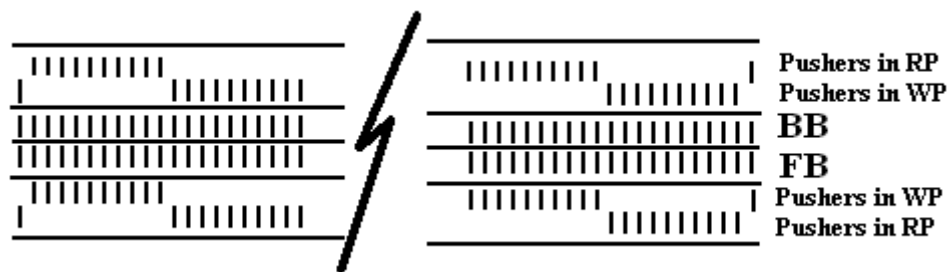
Handle down. Locks N/N. SS 3/3. Knit 1 row. Hang combs and weights.

Locks CX/CX. SS 4/4. Knit 2 rows.

Locks N/N. SS 6/6. Knit 1 row.

RC 000

Set up pushers L50-R50 in 10 up, 10 down position across bed. Set back bed up exactly opposite. Pusher L51 and R51 should be opposite of adjacent needle. See diagram below.



Black strippers. * Handle up. Locks BX <--/BX<--

Changing colors every 2 rows, knit 39 rows. End with COL.

Drop bed and fill the 10 pockets with fiberfill across the bed.

Close beds.

Handle down. Locks N/N. Knit 1 row.

DO NOT CHANGE COLORS ON THIS ROW!!*

Starting with the same color you just ended with repeat * to * to RC 400.

End with N/N row.

Transfer all sts to back bed.

Bind off loosely.
