

Smoking Needles Machine Knitting

DM80 Tuck Stitch Afghan

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You'll need at least 2 cones of 3-ply yarn. I used a discontinued yarn -- Heirloom Cambridge 3/15. At about 2800 yards per pound there was a small amount of yarn left. Could also be made with Tamm 3-ply but at only about 2400 yards per pound you would need two additional cones although only a small amount would be used. The other alternative would be to just make it a little shorter. Watch your cones and stop patterning when approximately 50 rows of yarn is left so that you can knit the border and bind off! Remember...necessity is the mother of invention. Finished afghan just about covers a full size bed.

Change colors EOR throughout. With MC SS 5/5 and using combs and weights and blue strippers, FNR CO 148 needles.

On FB remove pusher from rail for every needle in WP and place in rest position.

N/AX<-- SS 5/5 Knit 40 rows.

With MC place 10 pushers on each end in rest position, all others in work position.

Insert card 7 into card reader. Place isolation pins under needles R78, R64 and L64. (Refer to page 20 & 21 in manual.)

Attach Deco selector to lock and set to 4.

Knit to RC 960.

Detach Deco selector from lock.

With MC in lock, all pushers down, N/AX<--, Change locks to N/N. Knit to RC1000.

Locks N/N 2 rows.

Change SS to 7/7. Knit 1. COL.

Cast off zigzag fashion.
